

PARISH NURSE (Voluntary)

Hours per week: 3-6 hrs per week.

Location: St George's Church, Preston

Closing Date: 1st October 2026

St George's, Preston is looking to employ a **NMC Registered Nurse**, preferably with mental health experience, in a volunteer position to lead our new Parish Nursing Service. The role would entail helping to develop our work with those in need in Preston City centre. St George's Church currently runs a kitchen for the homeless and those in need on Saturday evenings (*George's Kitchen*) and the Parish Nurse would attend these and offer advice and help to customers. Our hope is that a Parish Nurse would be able to come alongside such people to discuss their difficulties and help with basic mental and physical health advice as well as offering prayer and spiritual encouragement where appropriate.

The parish nurse role includes:

- General health education.
- Mental health support.
- Engaging mental health support with spirituality and faith where requested.
- Advocating for individuals and health more widely.
- Acting as a health navigator and resource.
- Liaising with other local services.

Current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) is essential and support for revalidation can be provided. A confidential declaration and enhanced DBS check will also be required from applicants.

The person will be required to undertake formal role preparation and to offer spiritual care and Christian prayer when requested (it is therefore a Genuine Occupational Requirement for the applicant to be a Christian).
